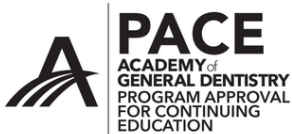

## Intensive course program for Laminate Veneers

Structured to blend clinical protocols through lectures & hands-on

### Course Description:

This comprehensive hands-on course is designed for dental clinicians seeking to master modern porcelain veneer workflows and bonded esthetic prototypes through both analog and digital approaches. Led by internationally renowned instructor Dr. Johan Figueira, the program combines evidence-based concepts, clinical demonstrations, and practical exercises to help participants confidently diagnose, plan, prepare, and cement highly esthetic ceramic restorations.

The course begins with an in-depth exploration of Bonded Functional Esthetic Prototypes and their role in treatment planning, smile visualization, and patient communication. Participants will then progress into a detailed study of Ceramic Laminate Veneers, including case selection, indications, preparation designs, and material selection for predictable esthetic outcomes.

Special emphasis will be placed on minimally invasive preparation techniques, including minimal-prep, guided, and no-prep cases, while integrating both digital and conventional workflows to optimize accuracy and efficiency in daily practice.

Throughout the two-day intensive program, clinicians will develop the practical knowledge and hands-on skills necessary to perform diagnostic wax-ups, veneer preparation, adhesive cementation, finishing protocols, and esthetic integration techniques that deliver natural, predictable, and long-lasting results – from single anterior veneers to full smile rehabilitations.
